

RESOLUTION 15-16

RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN MUNICIPAL REAL ESTATE NO LONGER USED,
NEEDED OR REQUIRED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City of Laurens, Iowa, a municipal corporation located in Pocahontas County, Iowa, is the owner of the following described real estate, to wit:

Lot One (1) in Block Twelve (12) in Sub-Division of Outlot Four (4) in the Town of Laurens, Iowa, Pocahontas County, Iowa

WHEREAS, said real estate above specifically described is at the present time neither used, needed or required for any municipal purposes whatsoever, is not needed for the use of the public, its maintenance at public expense is no longer justified, and is not presently required for any purposes, and should accordingly be disposed of by the City of Laurens, Iowa.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Laurens, Iowa as follows:

Section 1: That the following described real estate, to wit:

otherwise known as 202 S Fourth Street

is no longer used, needed or required for any municipal purposes whatsoever and that the same should be disposed of pursuant to Section 364.7 of the Code of Iowa (2015), as amended.

Section 2: All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed and that this Resolution shall be effective forthwith upon its passage and approval.
